- For the 2019 Missionfest that was held October 24-26. Over 200 participants from over 50 mission agencies attended. SLM Ghana gave out sample lessons to over 100 participants who signed up for the materials.

- For 54 new children who have been enrolled at our school and for the sponsorships provided to keep them in school
